3 & 4. Made from Venezuelan beans, these bars come in rich Apamate dark and Icoa white chocolate. (\$26 for 6: chocolateselrey.com)

5. Following the Mayan tradition of flavoring cocoa with spices, Green & Black's Maya Gold fuses dark chocolate, orange, cinnamon and nutmeg. (\$4)
